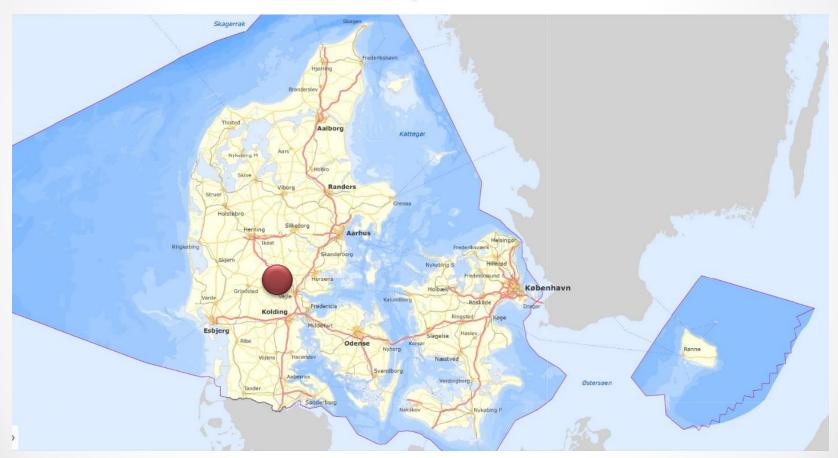

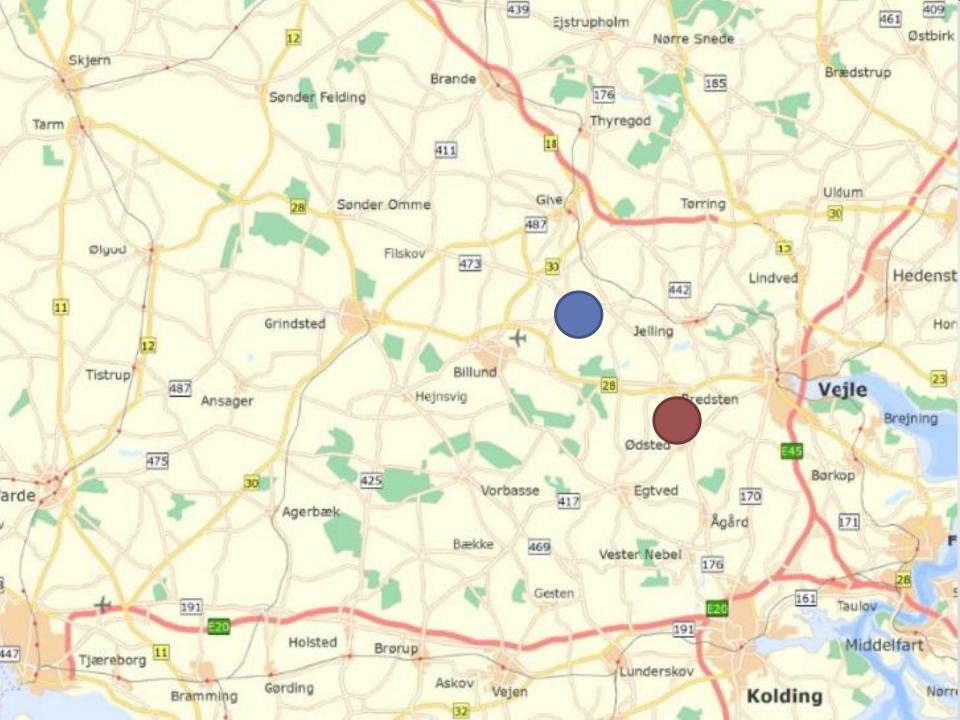

## **Field Production**

- Grain
  - 700 ha with grain barley, wheat, rye, oats.
- Blueberries + potatoes
  - 25 ha
- Cattle and grass lands
  - 65 ha protected grass land with Hereford cattle herd

Fieldplan 2013 covers 800 ha

# **Pig Production Today**

o 1,000 sows

- We sell 31,000 pigs per year
  - 7,000 30 kg pigs
  - 24,000 finishers at 105 kg
- Gilt Production to replaces sow herd

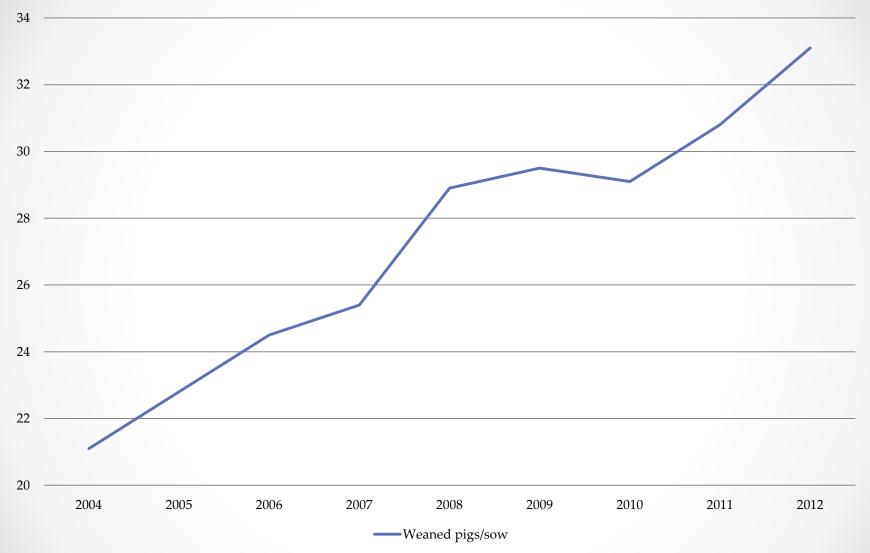

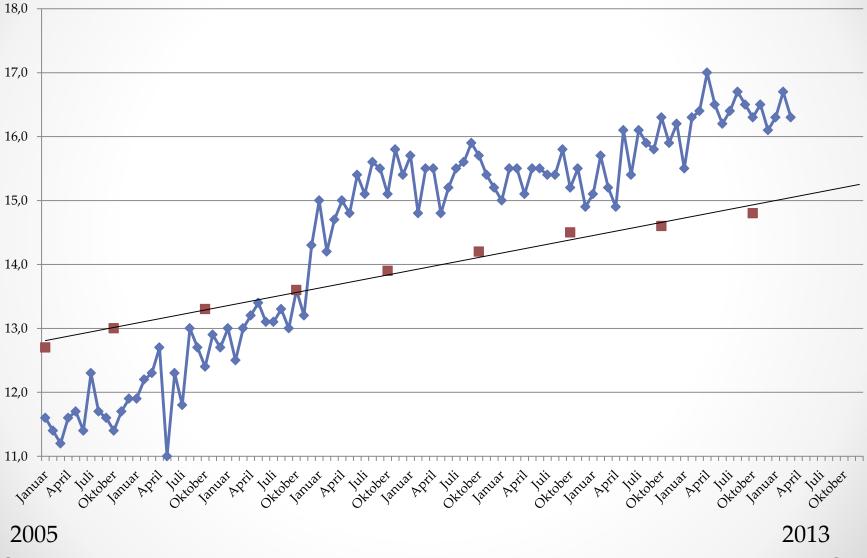
